In order to successfully complete each year a student has to pass all the exams envisaged by the study programme, receive positive assessment from his/her supervisor and submit a report, which include all the achievements gained throughout the academic year. In order to successfully complete the first year, the PhD student is obliged to complete the following courses:

Theories of Politics and International Relations or Comparative Politics (for the PS track) and *Theories of Culture and Identity and Culture or Interpreting Culture* (for the CS track). The *Teaching Methods I, Research Design, Academic Writing* as well as *Quantitative Research Methods or Qualitative Research Methods* are obligatory in the first year for both tracks.

The PhD student is obliged to commence the PhD procedure by the end of the third year and in the course of the studies, publish at least one academic article in a peer-reviewed journal.
